The SO (south-east) cup is a series of small orienteering competitions in the southern part of Austria (and sometimes also in the neighbouring countries) in the winter and beginning spring. The terrain was flat with some bigger valleys and some pathes to give you good arrest lines. So my o-technique was quite simple: keep a good direction, run full speed until the last big feature an then do a careful control attack. But I have to admit that I had problems with orienteering on small features on a really flat terrain. That's also why I was slightly insecure on my way to control 11 and I lost some time there. Some more training! But for the rest my race was ok and I'm also happy with the speed I was able to keep in the forest.
